- "We reported in late November how an article in a newsletter published at Johns Hopkins University showed that total deaths in the US have not increased dramatically in 2020 when compared to prior years. This article was taken down."
- "(Johns Hopkins) university claimed (later) that the study they took down should be considered with what the WHO and the CDC say on the matter. Therefore, we believe that the only measurement we can use to really see the impact of COVID is overall deaths." - "ATLANTA, Ga. (WEYI) The Centers for Disease Control released information showing how many people who died from COVID-19 had [2.6 avg] comorbidities or underlying conditions..." "The CDC said: Table 3 shows the types of health conditions and contributing causes mentioned in deaths involving coronavirus disease 2019. For 6% of the deaths, COVID-19 was the only cause mentioned. For deaths with conditions or causes in addition to COVID-19, on average, there were 2.6 additional conditions or causes per death:"
- * Influenza and pneumonia * Respiratory failure *Hypertensive disease *Diabetes * Vascular and unspecified dementia * Cardiac Arrest *Heart failure * Renal failure * Intentional and unintentional injury, poisoning and other adverse events * Other medical conditions "According to the CDC 9,683 died in the United States with only having COVID-19 listed on their death certificate."

The same story was also carried by ABC, NBC, MSN, FOX and Christian Post, but other sources challenged it as "misleading".
